This OT Sports white home jersey was worn by winger Bob MacMillian during the Trax final season. The Trax played in three different leagues during their three seasons, making the playoffs each year and runner up to the league champions twice. MacMillian played for three years in Junior A in the mid-nineties before joining the Trax, playing in 35 games, with two goals and four assists, and a whopping 201 minutes in penalties. The jersey shows nice game wear which includes tears in the sleeve area and stick marks and pilling on the front. The embroidered primary team logo is sewn on the front and the shoulders have a pair of embroidered secondary logos. The numbers are sewn two color twill. The sewn nameplate has twill letters, and the stitching did not overlap the edges of some of the letters, causing some fraying. This may have been a team added nameplate since MacMillian joined the team after the start of the season. Other features include the embroidered OT Sports logo patch sewn on the back hem, an embroidered Cox Communications sponsor patch sewn on the upper right front chest. A 1st Armored Division patch is sewn on the upper left front chest. MacMillian's autograph is found on the bottom of the number 5 on the back. I acquired the jersey from a fan in Macon who purchased the jersey at an auction following the team's last regular season home game.
