

Gwinnett Gladiators Jim Jackson 2003-04 inaugural season game worn jersey, size 56.

Marquette, Michigan native Jim Jackson played four seasons of college hockey for Northern Michigan University before his first pro season with Gwinnett. He played in 65 games, scoring twelve times with 21 assists for 33 points. Jackson played for Gwinnett during four subsequent seasons, including some call-ups to the AHL. This black road jersey by OT Sports from the first half of the season shows great game wear. The embroidered Gladiator crest is sewn on the front, along with two smaller alternate logo patches on each shoulder. The embroidered county name Gwinnett is found in located below the neckline. There is no Kroger sponsor patch or any evidence that one was on this jersey, suggesting that the Kroger patch was not affixed to the road jerseys during the first half of the inaugural season. Jackson's name in gold twill letters is sewn to a matching fabric nameplate. Two color sewn twill numbers are on the back and sleeves. Sewn on the back hem are the embroidered Meigray, ECHL and OT Sports patches. It came with a letter of authenticity from Meigray and the ECHL. The jersey was purchased from an eBay auction.
