

Gwinnett Gladiators Bruce Mulherin 2006-07 game worn jersey, size 56.

Born in Red Deer, Alberta, Bruce Mulherin played four years at the NCAA level for the University of Alabama in Huntsville. In his junior and senior years, Mulherin played in 64 games, totaling 74 points, leading to Mulherin being offered a roster spot with the Gwinnett Gladiators of the ECHL for 2006-07. In his professional debut, Mulherin scored 11 points in 30 games, and was traded mid-season to the Toledo Storm. After one more season in the ECHL in 2007-08, Mulherin played three years overseas in Europe and Asia before retiring from pro hockey. This white SP jersey from the first half of the season has the classic embroidery over twill Gladiator logo sewn on the front, along with the usual embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. The pair of smaller alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders. The two color twill numbers are sewn on, as is the matching nameplate with single color letters. On the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the ECHL embroidered logo patch that is sewn on. I acquired it directly from Meigray.
