

Gwinnett Gladiators Dirk Southern 2008-09 game worn jersey, size 54.

Dirk Southern split the 2008-09 season between Gwinnett and the Manitoba Moose of the American Hockey league. In 51 games with the Gladiators, Southern posted 46 points with 14 goals and 32 assists. Originally drafted by Anaheim in the 2003 NHL Entry Draft, Southern finished college at Northern Michigan before turning pro in 2006 with the Augusta Lynx. This white SP jersey from the first half of the season has an embroidery over twill Gladiator primary logo sewn on the front, along with the usual embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. An embroidered Gwinnett wordmark logo patch is sewn just below the neckline. Two alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders, as are the two color twill numbers and the black nameplate with single color letters. On the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo, with the embroidered Meigray patch sewn on the opposite side.
