

Atlanta Gladiators Brad Miller 2011-12 game worn jersey, size 54.

Alpharetta, Georgia native Brad Miller turned pro in the ECHL after playing four seasons for the University of North Dakota Fighting Hawks. After stops in Idaho, Trenton and Elmira, Miller skated with the Gladiators for one season, playing in 35 games with six goals and 10 assists. The following season, Miller, like many young players, decided to head overseas and test the hockey market in Europe. This white set 1 jersey by SP exhibits light wear. The classic embroidered Gladiator logo is sewn to the front, along with the embroidered oval Kroger sponsor patch. A Gladiators wordmark logo patch is sewn on just below the front neckline. Embroidered alternate logo patches are sewn on each shoulder. The numbers are all sewn two color twill and the matching fabric nameplate has single color sewn twill letters. The rear hemline has an embroidered Meigray patch on the left, an embroidered ECHL patch on the right and the SP logo is also embroidered directly to the jersey.
