

Gwinnett Gladiators Colin Vock 2011-12 game worn jersey, size 54.

Michigan native Colin Vock played four seasons at the University of Vermont from 2006-10. After graduation, he earned 37 points (15G-22A) in 45 games with Rosenborg Elite of the Norwegian GET-ligaen before being signed by Gwinnett. Vock played 28 games during 2011-12 (5G-8A) before being traded to Utah in January. This black SP jersey from the first half of the season has an embroidery over twill Gladiator primary logo sewn on the front, along with the usual embroidered Kroger sponsor patch. An embroidered Gwinnett wordmark logo patch is sewn just below the neckline. Two alternate logo patches are sewn on the shoulders, as are the two color twill numbers and the black nameplate with single color letters. On the back hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo, with the embroidered Meigray patch sewn on the opposite side. There is some significant wear, especially on the left sleeve. I acquired it directly from Meigray.
