Salem, Oregon native Aaron McGill played parts of all three seasons of the Riverhawks history in Augusta. In 73 games, McGill netted 16 goals and 30 assists for 46 points, with 297 penalty minutes. During the 2010-11 campaign, McGill was suspended for the remainder of the season following a February 12 game when he sucker-punched Knoxville's Mark Van Vliet, causing a huge brawl to break out. The punch broke Van Vliet's jaw, forcing him to have surgery the next day and miss the rest of the season. This blue Riverhawks jersey by OT Sports has very light wear. The embroidered alternate logo stitched to the front, along with a screened Cintas sponsor patch sewn on the upper right breast. The embroidered SPHL logo appears at the base of the V neck. The numbers are two color twill and the rear hem has a large Doctor's Hospital sponsor patch consisting of a screened logo on white twill.
