

Columbus Cottonmouths Cody Freeman 2015-16 game worn helmet.

After three seasons of junior hockey, Toronto native Cody Freeman enrolled at Canisius College and played four years of college hockey. In his senior year, he was one of five players to play in all 37 games during the season. Freeman ranked third on the team in points with 10 goals and 16 assists and tied for the team lead with three game-winning goals. After college, he entered the pro ranks with the Evansville Icemen of the ECHL in March 2015, playing in eight games. For the 2015-16 season, Freeman signed with the Adirondack Thunder, played in two preseason games, but did not play in any regular season games. He joined the Cottonmouths in December, playing in 44 games with 8 goals and 10 assists. This royal blue Easton E400 helmet was designed for increased air flow through the helmet. It has Freeman's #49 on front and back, SPHL and the Cottonmouths 20th anniversary stickers on the lower back and Wolf Autoworks sponsor stickers on the right and left. A Tron S40 shield is attached. I acquired this helmet directly from the team.
