This Custom Crafted black jersey has a Trimark neck tag and a Sonic Drive-In screened sponsor patch on the upper right chest. The large snake head logo on the front is screened over white twill that has been stitched to the center of the chest. On the right and left lower seams there is a triangular piece of blue nylon on which is screened the CC logo with the snake heads with large fangs. The snake logos on the sleeves are screened onto white twill and sewn on. The numbers are white twill with the red borders and snake heads screened on and then attached with wide red zigzag stitching that conceals most of the red screened trim. The yellow tongue on the large number on the back consists of sewn on twill, while the tongues on the smaller sleeve numbers are created using a simple zigzag stitch. The Custom Crafted logo at the bottom center of the rear hem is screened on. The nameplate is sewn on and letters are white twill and there is a fight strap. Brown played in 52 games for the Cottonmouths during the 98-99 season before being dealt to Wichita. He also played for the Macon Whoopee during the previous year, having been acquired in a trade that season from Memphis. It was acquired from an eBay auction.
