Dylon McKinlay was drafted by the Minnesota Wild in the 2010 NHL entry draft in the seventh round. After playing five seasons of junior hockey, McKinlay enrolled at the University of Regina where he played in 27 of the team's 28 Canada West games and led the team in both assists (12) and points (17) in his rookie season. McKinlay joined the Cottonmouths in December, 2015 and played in 26 games in his first pro season, with one goal and five assists for six points. These Easton Pro gloves have McKinlay's number 13 written on the thumb with black Sharpie. The right palm is worn through and there are numerous stick marks and small tears. The Cottonmouths team name is embroidered on the cuff area. They were acquired directly from the team.
