

**Columbus Cottonmouths Henrik Arnstrom 2005-06 game worn jersey, size 56.**

Sweden native Henrik Arnstrom began the 2005-06 hockey season on the Toledo Storm's training camp roster and after his release he was acquired by Columbus. In his one and only season with the Cottonmouths, Arnstrom played in all but one regular season game and in all three post-season games. The following season, Arnstrom was signed by the Quad City Mallards of the United Hockey League but only played one game for the Mallards before being placed on waivers. It appears that Arnstrom then returned to Sweden. This SP lace up jersey from the Snakes' second season in the SPHL has the embroidered Cottonmouths logo sewn on the front. The SP logo is embroidered directly to the upper left chest area. An embroidered SPHL Champions patch is sewn on the upper right chest, commemorating the Cottonmouths' winning the inaugural President's Cup the previous season. The sleeves have twin snake head logos and three color sewn twill numbers. On the back are sewn on three color twill numbers and a fabric nameplate with sewn heat pressed letters. Below the player number on the back is a sewn on screened Jay Auto Mall sponsor patch. On the rear hem is the embroidered SP logo and an embroidered SPHL logo patch. It shows great game wear, especially on the sleeves. It bears a player autograph on the rear number. It was purchased from another collector.
