

**Columbus Cottonmouths Jordan Braid 2013-14 game worn jersey, size 54.**

Saskatchewan native Jordan Braid first entered the ranks of professional hockey in 2010 with the Cottonmouths after junior hockey. He was the team's leading scorer during the 2011-12 championship season. Midway through the 2013-14 season, Braid was traded to the Louisiana Ice Gators following a lackluster performance during the first half. The front of this white OT Sports jersey has an embroidered sewn on snake head logo with the team name embroidered around the circumference. The back and sleeves have sewn on two color twill snake head numbers. There is a sewn on matching cloth nameplate with sewn on single color letters on the back. The right rear hem has a sewn on embroidered OT Sports logo while the left hem has a sewn on embroidered SPHL 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary patch. A smaller SPHL anniversary patch is sewn to the front lace up neckline. On the left shoulder is a sewn on embroidered snake head patch. On the right shoulder is a sewn on embroidered patch in the outlines of the states of Georgia and Alabama with the state flags and the snake head logo. Sponsor patches include a sewn on embroidered Hughston Hospital sponsor patch on the right front breast, a sewn on embroidered Sunshine Banners & Signs patch at the center of the rear hemline and a sewn on embroidered ASA Performance patch above the player nameplate. The jersey has moderate wear. I purchased this directly from the team.
