

**Columbus Cottonmouths Max Cook 2014-15 game worn jersey, size 54.**

Illinois native Max Cook played four years of college hockey at Miami University in Ohio before being signed by the Evansville IceMen in 2014. Cook was sent to Peoria, the SPHL affiliate, and played only one game before being released and acquired by the Cottonmouths. Cook played in forty games for Columbus, netting only three goals with nine assists in his one and only professional season. The front of this green OT Sports jersey has an embroidered sewn on snake head logo with the team name embroidered around the circumference. On the right upper chest is an embroidered sewn on Hughston Hospital sponsor patch. The back and sleeves have sewn on two color twill snake head numbers. On the back there is a contrasting sewn on cloth nameplate with sewn on single color letters. The rear hem has an embroidered OT Sports logo patch and a sewn on embroidered SPHL patch. A smaller SPHL patch is sewn to the front lace up neckline. Centered on the rear hem is a sewn on embroidered Sunshine Banners & Signs sponsor patch. The jersey shows good game wear.
