

**Columbus Cottonmouths Orrin Hergott 2004-05 authentic jersey, size 54.**

Saskatchewan native Orrin Hergott is the only player to have suited up for each of the first nine seasons of the Southern Professional Hockey League, all with the Cottonmouths. Upon his retirement after the 2012-13 season he held the record for most games played in the SPHL-404. Nicknamed "Scorin' Orrin" by fans, his number 11 was retired by the team at the conclusion of the 2012-13 season. The front of this white SP jersey has embroidered sewn on alternate logo along with an embroidered SP logo. The back and sleeves have sewn on three color twill numbers. There is a sewn on cloth nameplate with sewn on single color letters on the back. The right rear hem has an embroidered SP logo and a sewn on embroidered SPHL patch. On the left shoulder is a sewn on embroidered United States Army Infantry School insignia patch, a tribute to the school that is located at nearby Fort Benning. On the right shoulder is a sewn on embroidered American flag patch. The only thing missing is the JAY Auto Mall sponsor patch that would be located on the right front breast. There are some unknown stains on the front and right sleeve. I purchased this from an eBay auction and did the customization myself.
