

Columbus Cottonmouths Patrick Murphy 2015-16 game worn pants, size M.

St. Catharines, Ontario native Patrick Murphy signed his first pro contract with the Cottonmouths on March 25th after five seasons of junior hockey. In his professional debut, Murphy had a goal and assist, but this would be all the scoring he would have in seven games with the Snakes. Columbus chose not to protect him in the SPHL Expansion Draft and he was claimed by Evansville. These royal blue Easton Mako pants show great game wear. The wear pattern on the embroidered Easton logo on the left leg resulted in a photo match to pictures taken of Murphy during the final home games of the season. The number 81 is written with a black Sharpie on the inside so these pants may also have been used by Chad Bennett before Murphy joined the team. I obtained these pants from another collector who acquired them directly from the team.
