

**Gwinnett Gladiators Will Colbert 2011-12 game worn jersey, size 54.**

Defenseman Will Colbert was drafted by Ottawa in 2003 and then by San Jose in 2005. After four years of junior hockey and four years playing at the collegiate level, Colbert turned pro for the 2009-10 season. He spent the next two seasons with the Gladiators before heading to Europe to play for two seasons before retiring from professional hockey. In 119 regular season games with the Gladiators, Colbert scored 8 goals with 22 assists. This black SP jersey from the first half of the season has the embroidered Gladiator primary logo sewn on the front, along with the Kroger sponsor patch. An embroidered Gwinnett wordmark logo patch is sewn just below the neckline. Two embroidered alternate logo patches are sewn on each shoulder, as are the two color twill numbers and the black nameplate with single color letters. On the rear hem the SP logo is embroidered to the jersey next to the sewn on ECHL embroidered logo patch, and the embroidered Meigray patch sewn on the opposite side. The jersey exhibits good wear on the sleeves and pilling on the bottom hem. I acquired it from Meigray via an eBay auction and later sold this to another collector.
