

Atlanta Gladiators Zach Malatesta 2017-18 game worn jersey, size 54.

Zach Malatesta grew up in Boston, Massachusetts and spent three seasons in the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League posting 92 points (25g-67a) and a +18 rating in 191 games. During his final year in the QMJHL, Malatesta started the season with the Moncton Wildcats, posting three goals and five assists in 25 games before being dealt to Acadie-Bathurst before the trade deadline. In 33 games with Acadie-Bathurst, Malatesta put up the best numbers of his career with 28 points (8g-20a) and a +27 rating in 33 games. In his first professional season with the Gladiators, he posted one goal and ten assists for 10 points. This white CCM jersey has the large Gladiator logo embroidered on, with the smaller alternate logo patches sewn on the shoulders. The embroidered Kroger and the 15th Anniversary patches are sewn on the upper right chest and left chest respectively. Embroidered patches that bear the CCM logo are found below the front and back necklines. The two color twill numbers are sewn on, as is the matching fabric player nameplate with single color sewn twill letters. In the center of the back hem is a sewn on screened ECHL logo. Above the hem on the right side is a sewn on embroidered ECHL 30th anniversary patch. This jersey has great game wear and was purchased from the team equipment sale at the end of the season.
