

Columbus Cottonmouths Rich Metro 2000-01 game worn jersey, size 54.

Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan native Rich Metro played 24 games for Columbus in 2000-01, posting 3 goals and 3 assists before being placed on waivers in mid-January. He was picked up by the Asheville Smoke in the UHL for the remainder of the season. Metro spent the next several years playing in France before retiring and pursuing a coaching career. This red home Christmas jersey has rubberized snake head logos that are screened onto white twill and sewn on the front and on both shoulders. The Santa hat consists of sewn on twill. The Peachtree Mall sponsor patch is screened on twill and sewn to the upper right chest. The sewn on snake numbers were made by screening a blue rubberized layer over white twill, with the yellow tongues and white eyes either sewn twill or stitched. The matching cloth nameplate with single color sewn twill letters is sewn on back. On the back hemline the CHL logo and the Custom Crafted logo are both embroidered directly to the jersey. Finishing off this masterful jersey is an embroidered Custom Crafted neck tag. The jersey also bears Craig Stahl's autograph on the Santa hat. I acquired this from another collector.
