

Columbus Cottonmouths Jordan Braid 2010-11 game worn jersey, size unknown.

2010-11 was Saskatchewan native Jordan Braid's first season of professional hockey after four years of junior hockey. In 54 games, Braid lit the lamp 17 times and added 17 assists for 34 points. Braid also led the team in the plus/minus column. The front of this white OT Sports jersey has an embroidered sewn on snake head logo with the team name across the mouth. A sewn on embroidered Hughston Hospital sponsor patch is on the right front breast area. A small SPHL logo patch is sewn to the front neckline. The back and sleeves have sewn on two color twill numbers. There is a sewn on matching cloth nameplate with sewn on single color letters on the back. The right rear hem has a sewn on embroidered OT Sports logo while the left hem has a sewn on embroidered SPHL patch. On both shoulders are embroidered snake head patches. The player has autographed the jersey on the rear just to the right of the number. There is evidence of a size tag in the neck area but it was missing when acquired but it is consistent with a size 54 or 56 based on the chest measurement. The jersey exhibits good game wear. I purchased this directly from another collector.
