



Charitable Giving Information

Susan O'Brien, Director of Communications and Development of the Diocese of Sioux City, has recently sent the following information to our parishes as it relates to the new **CARES Act**. It might be of interest to some of you as it relates to your gift to your parish.

"As you know, Congress passed the new CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security) Act designed to help you through the economic hardship caused by the coronavirus global pandemic. Here are a few of the key provisions of this new law as it relates to philanthropic support.

The new law **temporarily suspends the requirements for required minimum distributions** (RMD) for the 2020 tax year. This probably comes as a relief to many people who would have had to withdraw a greater percentage of their retirement accounts. Many donors use their RMD to make a gift from their IRA. If a donor is 70½ or older, they can still make a gift from your IRA or name us as a beneficiary. In addition, there are some new ways you can receive financial benefits and help organizations like us.

The new law **allows all taxpayers to take a charitable deduction of up to \$300, even if you do not itemize**. You might think that this is a small amount and would not make a difference. But what if all of our donors gave "just" \$300? Such support would have a huge impact on those we serve.

For those who do itemize their deductions, the new law allows for cash contributions to qualified charities such as ours to be deducted up to 100% of your adjusted gross income for the 2020 calendar year.

Please tell your donors to always consult with their tax professional about their charitable giving decisions, especially with these new provisions from the CARES Act.
