

Let us praise those fathers who have lost a child to death and continue to hold the child in their heart.


Let us praise those men who have no children, but cherish the next generation as if they were their own.

Let us praise those men who are about to become fathers; may they openly delight in their children.


And let us praise those fathers who have died, but live on in our memory and whose love continues to nurture us.

Churches Open for Private Prayer

Bishop Nickless has authorized the opening of churches for private prayer. Each of our cluster parishes is available for private prayer for **two hours per week from 4:00-6:00 p.m.**
More information follows:



Mondays: Rockwell City

Tuesdays: Lake City

Wednesdays: Manson

Note that this a time for private prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. This is NOT a time for the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament or common public prayers (e.g., The Divine Mercy Chaplet). This time is for private prayer only.

We ask that no more than 10 people be in the church at one time. Therefore, we ask that you make visits short, rotating in and out every 10-15 minutes, which will allow other parishioners to have the opportunity for private prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

For your protection and to ensure that proper sanitization of the pews and church fixtures occurs after the periods of prayer, we ask that you social distance yourselves in the pews without a blue X. Please bring and wear face masks as face masks are required for those utilizing the churches for private prayer.
