Whether it’s a mortgage, a loan from a family member, credit cards, or something else, most of us have some experience of being debtors. We feel the burden of knowing our creditors have some degree of power over us. At times it can feel like having a heavy yoke tied to our shoulders. We also know how freeing it is to be released from a debt. Making that final payment feels so good. In today’s second reading, St. Paul uses this image of indebtedness to encourage us: “We are not debtors to the flesh.” The flesh—that part of you that is attracted to sin—has no more power over you. Because you have been baptized, you have died to sin and no longer owe it any allegiance. Raised up with Christ, you now have a way out when temptation arises. Think how wonderful it feels to walk through a temptation and come out on the other side unharmed. Or think about how comforting it is to know that you don’t have to be bound by guilt or destined to repeat your past sins. Of course, this is easier said than done. St. Paul announces a truth that can sustain us if we should fall into sin. So if you lose a battle here or there, you can pray, “Lord, you know how weak I am, but I believe that this sin does not define me. Thank you, Jesus, for abolishing my debt to the flesh!”

Note From Fr. Lynn: This past weekend we began resuming public Mass at our churches again. We averaged 25 participants in attendance. I think that many of us are cautious, which I believe is a good thing. While I ask you to still sign up online or by calling the office, you will not need to adhere to every-other-week signup recommendation until we begin to experience greater numbers attending. Again, please note the restrictions that apply for attending Mass—face masks for everyone over age two and social distancing. This week we will begin weekday Mass two days per week. Weekday Mass will be scheduled with at least a one-day interim in between so the church can be sanitized. Because of the need for sanitation, we will suspend the previously scheduled private prayer time.

The following are precautions and changes necessary to resume Mass.

Seat reservation: There is a limited amount of seating available because of social distancing requirements. Please reserve your seat on our web page at calhouncatholic.org and click on “Sign Up for Weekend Mass.” Click on select date. Select date and Mass time, then click Register. Select “1” in the drop-down box, then click Register. Fill in contact information and select type of Attendee in drop-down box, then click Register.

- Ushers will seat you.** You are to enter the church from the main entrance only (rear of the church). Tell usher your name and number in your household, and they will seat you. People who live in the same household may sit together.
- Face masks:** Face masks are to be worn by all adults and children over the age of two years old. You are asked to provide your own face mask. If you do not have a face mask, one will be given to you prior to entering the church.
- Distribution of Holy Communion:** Communion will be distributed only in one form—the Host.
- Communion will be distributed after the conclusion of Mass—after the concluding blessing and dismissal.
- For each minister distributing communion, parishioners receiving communion will form a single line that incorporates the six-foot social distancing with the help of the ushers.
- As you approach to receive communion, you should form your hands into a throne to receive the Eucharist. Then step at least six feet away, pull down your mask with one hand while inserting the host into your mouth with the other hand.
- Upon receiving the host, immediately make your way toward the nearest exit of the church. Although you are not able to remain in church after receiving communion, you are highly encouraged to say prayers of thanksgiving in your vehicle.
