Sacrament of Reconciliation/Confession


New protocols for Sacrament of Reconciliation allow us to offer the sacrament in facilities again. We will use our parish halls to accommodate social distancing for the sacrament. Fr. Lynn will be available 30 minutes prior to Mass. A black cloth screen will be used, which Fr. Lynn will sit behind to hear confession. Both Fr. Lynn and penitent are to wear masks. Please stand in front of the screen to confess your sins, so as to prevent contact with any surfaces. If you cannot stand for confession, please call Fr. Lynn and make an appointment for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

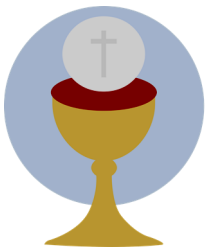

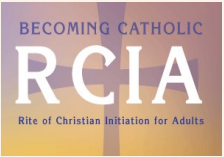
