LECTIO: THE CASE FOR JESUS

With limitations on gathering as communities still in place, reaching parishioners and strengthening their faith has become increasingly critical. This Lent, the Augustine Institute is grateful to offer FORMED parishes a new program: *Lectio: The Case for Jesus*.

In nine, 40- to 60-minute sessions that are accessible to parishioners on the FORMED website, Dr. Brant Pitre answers the key question of faith: Who is Jesus? Dr. Pitre looks in-depth at the gospel accounts of Jesus's Crucifixion and Resurrection and the proclamation of his divinity.

The first four sessions answer Catholics' common questions about the Bible. The second two sessions look at the statements that Jesus made about who he was. Sessions seven and eight explore Jesus's death and Resurrection. In the last session, Dr. Pitre answers questions regarding the material covered over the course of the study.

Access to *Lectio: The Case for Jesus* opens on February 17, Ash Wednesday.

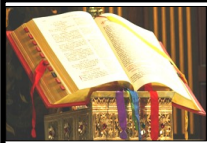

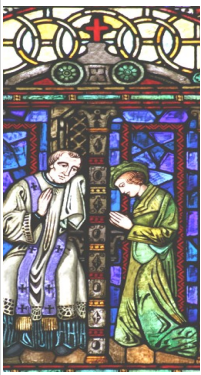
