memorial DAY

The church office will be closed on **Monday, May 31**, for the Memorial Day holiday.

LITURGICAL PROTOCOLS

Bishop Nickless promulgated the following liturgical protocols **effective immediately**:

Obligation to Attend Mass

- Bishop Nickless is currently drafting a decree to reinstate the **obligation to attend Mass** on **June 5-6, 2021**, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). **There will be no livestreaming of the Mass starting June 5-6, 2021.**

Facemasks

- Facemasks are **no longer required** to be worn at liturgies, parish events, and in parish offices by those who have been **fully vaccinated**. Those who have been fully vaccinated and wish to continue wearing facemasks as a precaution may continue to do so.
- Those who have **not** been **fully vaccinated** (age 2 and above) are **strongly recommended** to continue **wearing a facemask** at liturgies, parish events, and in parish offices.

Sanitizer

- Parishes** are to continue **providing hand sanitizer** for liturgies and parish events.

Capacity

- Church capacity may return to **100% without social distancing** in the pews or the sanctuary.

Confessions

- Confessions may **return to normal spacing** within the church confessionals.

Music

- Congregational **singing may resume**.
- Hymnals, **missalette**s, and worship aids may be **resumed being used**.
- Choirs** may return **to normal** sizes.

The Celebration of Mass

- Holy water fonts** may be **filled for use**.
- Collections** may be **taken up** at the Offertory with baskets.
- The Offertory procession with the **presentation of the gifts** of bread and wine **may resume**.
- The **Sign of Peace**, which is an optional rite in the Mass, will continue to be **omitted**.
- Holy Communion** will continue to be distributed **only** under the **species of bread**.

Suicide Prevention Program


As communities across Iowa continue to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic, mental health challenges continue to impact Iowans at alarming rates. Suicide is among the top five leading causes of death for Iowans between the ages of 10 and 54 years old, according to the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention. In response to this continuing impact, Iowa State University Extension & Outreach is offering “Question. Persuade. Refer.” programs to faith community members across the state now through June. QPR is a suicide prevention program that teaches participants three steps to help save a life from suicide. ISU Extension and Outreach will offer QPR, Tuesday, June 1, from 12 to 1 pm; and Thursday, June 17, from 10 to 11 am. Private classes for groups of 10-20 participants are also available upon request. To register, go to <https://www.extension.iastate.edu/humansciences/QPR>. Participants will receive a unique URL prior to the program to access the Zoom hosted program.
