

**Catholic Cemetery Rules and Regulations**  
**Some general guidelines for decorations at St. Thomas Catholic Cemetery:**  
 All grave decorations must be on concrete installed at the end of the markers or permanently attached to the granite base or a "saddle" on the marker. Veterans' flags and flowers not in attached vases may be placed on the grave there (3) days in advance and removed by June 19th, 2024. This removal date is subject to change in 2025. A more complete set of Catholic Cemetery Rules and Regulations will be discussed at an upcoming Finance Committee meeting.

**THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK** If you or a loved one is homebound and would like to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact Fr. Lynn B., Fr. Brian Feller, or Fr. Jim Bruch. The time to call the priest for anointing is at the start of a serious illness—not at the very end—at the moment of death. Anointing of the Sick is one of the seven Catholic Sacraments and modes to experience God's grace.
