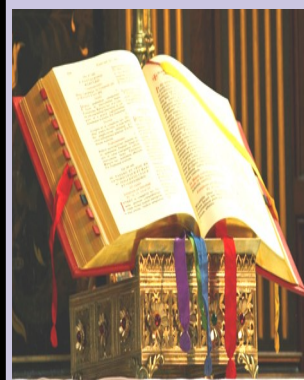

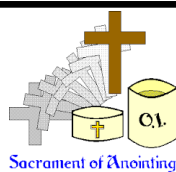
Giving thanks for summer!

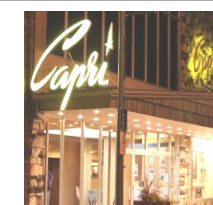
