Fr. Feller's Corner

In this Sunday's Gospel, Andrew says to Jesus, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?"

Here is the context. Thousands of people had followed Jesus to the countryside to listen to him teach. Jesus asked his disciples how they could feed the great number of people. Philip answered that they didn't have the money to buy enough food. Then Andrew volunteered a "hopeless" option, a boy with some bread and fish. But in the hands of Jesus, with a blessing from his Father, the "hopeless" few became the abundant many, and the many was enough for all.

Like those following Jesus, we might find ourselves in a "countryside" of being stretched by the demands of life, not making ends meet financially, or feeling a hunger for a more peaceful life. If we each can give a little to Jesus – whether in praying, volunteering, tithing, bringing our children to Mass, assisting the sick, homebound, and homeless, etc., Jesus will transform our gift with his divine touch. He does this at every Mass and wants to do it in our daily lives too!

I noticed examples of this transformation at the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. We who attended can't wait to share our stories in the weeks ahead.
