

While receiving from the Precious Chalice is Holy Communion, we now have low gluten hosts available. We would like to position them at various church sites as needed. United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has approved the use of these hosts in all dioceses. Hosts are made by the Benedictine Sisters of Perpetual Adoration in Clyde, MO. They are made from wheat starch (wheat flour-with most gluten protein removed) plus water. In the last gluten testing on this product, April 2023, the average content per wafer was 70ppm which equals 70 micrograms per .2 g of product. Each host weighs .2 grams.




