

## Fr. Feller's Corner

Our Lady of the Plains Parish is a family of multiple Catholic faith communities.

This is a new concept. And it is going to take time to understand what it means for each and all of us. I understand that these changes are being made throughout the diocese so that each pastor will have only one canonical parish (instead of multiple), fewer finance meetings for priests, and to position the diocese for when we have fewer priests. I am guessing that we have around 35 priests in our parishes with 14 of us being able to retire by 2032. I am hoping we will have 4-8 new priests between now and then.

We are concerned about the decrease in our number of priests and access to the sacraments (especially Eucharist, Confession, and Anointing of the Sick), I am also concerned about our sense of community. Our potluck and discussion at St. Joseph Church, Lohrville helped me reflect on this. THANK YOU to all who came and shared! Jesus calls us to follow him in community, not in isolation. In community we practice ■ loving as Jesus loves. In community we call God Our ■ Father. In community we invite others to join us in the ■ Christian life. Our community is not a social club that ■ exists for our own comfort and is closed to those "who ■ don't fit." We are meant to be a house with open doors ■ and transparent windows so that the world can see God working through our discipleship. Whether it is looking in our 'windows' or seeing the 'home' we return to each week, the world will want to make our Father's family, their family.



Traditionally, our sense of faith and community has been experienced around the celebration of Saturday/Sunday Mass. With fewer Masses in fewer places, communities of peoples have scattered to different towns and times and for weekend Mass. Our sense of belonging to a faith community with the people we live and work with has changed. When this is the case, we (while still attending weekend Mass somewhere) can find additional ways to come together in our faith communities whether at churches, parish halls, homes, or public venues. The more we can be together in following Jesus as the community of the Church, the more we can be a light and home to our civic communities and neighbors.
