Greetings to everyone at Our Lady of the Plains Parish. I am so glad you joined us for Mass today! As many of you are aware my role in serving the parish moved from DRE to include adult faith formation as well. If you don't know how to, that's a great conversation starter for meeting a new person in church!

My door is always open. Anyone is welcome to stop by to chat, ask questions, or check out the resources we have to deepen your faith life. Whenever we host a study or small group, we want YOU there. Bring your questions, doubts, hopes, ponderings, and testimonies; they are all part of the process to grow as a community.

Next month, we are starting an Advent reflection, you will hear more towards the end of the month. For planning purposes, know that after each weekend Mass in December we will have a short group gathering at each of our churches, all are welcome and encouraged to join us! In the new year look for information about our first Bible Study.


