................. **Fr. Feller's Corner**

Government elections have been in the news. Next week, we will celebrate the end of the liturgical year with Christ the King Sunday. Christ is a King. Between 1673-1675, Jesus appeared to the French nun, St. Margaret Marv Alacoque. Here is a selection of Jesus' words to her. They speak of what is at the heart of his kingship:

18 "My Divine Heart is so inflamed with love for men...being unable any longer to contain within Itself the flames of Its burning Charity. It must need to spread them abroad by your means, and manifest Itself to them (mankind) in order to enrich them with the precious graces of sanctification and salvation necessary to withdraw them from the abyss of perdition."

Jesus' kingship is one of love. "Jesus knew and loved us each and all 10 during his life, his agony, and his Passion and gave himself up for each one of us: 'The Son of God... loved me and gave himself for me.' He has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, 'is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that... love 18 with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human ■ beings' without exception" (CCC 478).

While on earth, Jesus' throne was a cross. When upon the cross his heart was pierced for our sins; blood and water flowed forth upon the earth. Within his Heart, the misery of mankind had met and been overcome by the mercy of God. 1 The fire of his love could not be overcome by the power of death. On the third day, 10 he rose from dead; overcoming the darkness of sin and death with the light of his ∎ love.

.... Jesus wants us to receive his love and live in his love: his Father's love. Daily, we can decide to live according to our Baptism as members of Christ's Kingdom - with Him as our King. The other option is very bad for us. "Viva Christo Rey!" - Long Live Christ the King! .


