Happy New Year! Thank you for your love and generosity towards our parish communities and to me. Thank you for your support, prayers, and gifts. I hope you experienced joy and delight as you celebrated the birth of Christ with your family, friends, and parish community. I also recognize the faith and fortitude of those who experienced various struggles over the holidays, especially those mourning the absence of loved ones. Jesus, the homeless and refugeed one, is with you. Jesus comes to walk with all of us and He invites us to follow Him a new way – His way.

Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6). After meeting Jesus, the magi departed for their homes a new way (Matthew 2:12). They declined to live according to the "old life" of Herod's way. Herod simply wanted to kill Jesus. Rather, the magi brought their life-changing encounters with the Christ-child back to the ordinary lives. We have the same options. It is a daily decision between the old life of sin and the new life of relationship and grace.

Having a grateful heart is the first step in the right direction with Jesus. Gratitude is our acknowledgement and appreciation for what God has done, is doing, and will do in our lives and for the world. St. Ignatius of Loyola teaches that gratitude is our response to encountering God in the little blessings of each day. These little blessings – such as breathing, walking, having work, knowing right from wrong, having a friend – come to us from the same love that suffers, dies, and rises to offer us salvation from sin and everlasting life. Gratitude makes us more receptive to the gifts.

St. Ignatius teaches that gratitude leads to our generosity – to give from what we have received. In closing, we join St. Ignatius in prayer:

Take, Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all I have and call my own. You have given all to me. To you, Lord, I return it. Everything is yours; do with it what you will. Give me only your love and your grace. That is enough for me.




