Last weekend at Mass, I mentioned three main ways we can unite in our Catholic
 communities. Here they are:

Get to know one another by name. We feel the impact when someone addresses us by name. Being known, accepted, and feeling that we belong helps us stay committed to our Catholic Faith communities when life gets tough. Being slow to leave after Mass gives us the opportunity to talk with friends and to strike up a conversation with those we don't know well. The unknown person is *Jesus the stranger*. Welcoming others, scooting over in the pews, and inviting one another to coffee and rolls, helps us live as a Holy Communion, the Body of Christ, who we receive in the Eucharist. You may never know the impact your kindness has on another life.

Support one another in our needs. It can be difficult to accept our limitations, weaknesses, or even that we have faults. It is much more difficult to let people know about and support us in our needs. But Jesus didn't come for those who have no needs. He came for those who have needs, especially the need of love and forgiveness amid sin. Jesus calls us to care for one another as we care for Him. Let's ask the Holy Spirit to make us available to give our ears of listening, our mouths of good words, and our hands of service to each other, especially those without the presence of a family or friend circle.

Grow in our faith together. Just as the aspen trees have strength by sharing a root system, we are stronger when we grow together. We can do this by coming together for adult faith formation, sharing Catholic videos, memes, posts with our text groups, and sharing "A Grace from Today" around the dinner table or in the car. I want the men of the parish to help me come up with ways we can come together in brotherhood (social media, texting, or in person) to help us grow in our faith during our ordinary workdays. I want the women of the parish to do the same as sisters. Please bring this topic up to me whenever you see me.

When you think about our parish communities, think about these three ways of living out the power of the Eucharist and becoming other Christs in the world.

What a great time to start a new habit!






