Jim, I deeply appreciate his friendship and presence. A couple of weeks ago, Fr. Jim moved to the Marian Home independent living in Fort Dodge. He was asked to offer daily Mass for the residents. Fr. Jim has faithfully embraced this new ministry.

I would like our parish groups to work together to honor and thank Fr. Jim and Fr. Boes sometime late this Spring. They are both celebrating their 60th anniversaries of priestly ordination. Fr. Boes has been residing and serving at St. Francis longer than I have been a priest! Gratitude and prayers for both fine priests!

Given this change in personnel, I want to clarify a couple of daily Mass details:

- I have a goal for daily Mass to be offered in each main church twice per week.
- On occasion, a religious education Mass is offered in Manson and Lake City. •
- The Thursday night prison Mass and the Friday morning Lake City nursing home Mass remain. If there is a volunteer who can help at the nursing home Mass, please contact me.
- There are two upcoming scheduled Masses in Lohrville on March 15th and 19th. After these Masses, I will have less availability to schedule Holy Day Masses in Auburn, Pomeroy, and Lohrville. I will try to offer Mass in these churches on a weekday in the future.
- For St. Thomas and St. Mary when school is late due to poor road conditions from the weather, daily morning Mass is canceled; it is not cancelled due to cold temperatures.
- We have many Mass intentions, but now have fewer daily masses. If you are open to having some your Masses offered elsewhere by retired

or missionary priests, please let our office know.
