. One of the nice things about being Catholic is repetition and structure. This holds true when the structure of our calendar repeats seasons each year. Always having the Lenten and Easter seasons calls us to intentionally embrace the gift of our Baptism into Christ's life, death, and resurrection. Rather than repetition becoming a mindless ritual, let's embrace it as practice and a means to deeper conversion. Back in 2017 Pope

"Lent is a new beginning, a path leading to the certain goal of Easter, Christ's victory over death. This season urgently calls us to conversion. Christians are asked to return to God 'with all their hearts' (Joel 2:12), to refuse to settle for mediocrity and to grow in friendship with the Lord. Jesus is the faithful friend who never abandons us. Even when we sin, he patiently awaits our return; by that patient expectation, he shows us his readiness to forgive. Lent is a favorable season for deepening our spiritual life through the means of sanctification offered us by the Church: fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. At the basis of everything is the Word of God, which during this season we are invited to

Intentionally embrace Christ this Lent! How can we? We can do so by praying Evening Prayer, Lenten reflections, the daily Rosary, or Stations of the Cross. We can fast from cursing, mindless screen time, sugars, alcohols, unnecessary purchases, etc. We can give alms through supporting our special collections, Cross Catholic Outreach, our food pantries, invite someone to church, buy fish fry tickets for someone who can't repay you. The purpose of Lent is not self-perfection, it is belonging more and more to Jesus and living his life of divine love. Some might simply grow by picking up littered trash in the ditches while meditating on the Lord's compassion for the smallest details of




