The Fiscal Officer selection committee recommended to council the selection of Heather Maloon as Fiscal Officer for the Village of Zoar. Patty will train Heather as an independent contractor at \$450 per month. Patty anticipates Heather will be trained by the end of October but she will always be just a telephone call away if Heather needs her. Gayle made a motion for Scott to contact Heather with an offer. The motion was seconded by Judy. Roll Call: All yes.

Council discussed uses for the potential Cares Act funding. Suggestions were for Scott to get estimates on the cleaning of Town Hall and the Schoolhouse. Scott will also get pricing on Air Cleaners and UV light cleaning devices. Council also proposed giving some of the funding to local businesses who had to shut down and lost a considerable amount of revenue. Scott will talk with Donnie's Tavern concerning its losses during shutdown. Gayle will talk with the Coffee Shop and the Star Co-op concerning losses.

Paul Worley attended and suggested the Village assist ZCA with some of the funding.

Scott will forward all estimates and further discuss at the next regular council meeting in October.

A motion to adjourn was made by Judy and seconded by Gayle.
