## Chapter 13

## Our Great High Priest

In the Old Testament there is mention of a somewhat mysterious person by the name of Melchizedek. Melchizedek is said to have been a king and a priest, who first appeared to Abraham upon his return from saving his brother-in-law, Lot: And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. Genesis 14:18. Spoken of in Psalms is a future priest after the order of Melchizedek, which is a prophecy concerning Jesus Christ: The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. The Lord hath sworn and will not repent, Thou art a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek. Psalms 110:1, 4.

The writer of Hebrews, in the New Testament, speaks of Jesus Christ as the one who is a priest forever, after the order of Melchizedek. So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared; though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; and being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him; called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec. Hebrews 5:5-10.

Jesus Christ, the great high priest offered himself as the one sacrifice for all men, and lives forever to make intercession for men before God. And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest, who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. For there is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof. For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God. And inasmuch as not without an oath he was made priest: (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) by so much was Jesus made a surety of a better testament. And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by reason of death: but this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself. For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, maketh the Son, who is consecrated for evermore. Hebrews 7:15-28.

The one mediator between God and men of which Paul wrote in his first letter to Timothy, is our great high priest, Jesus Christ, who gave himself as a ransom for all, and who makes intercession for us before God.

In the Book of Acts, it is explained that Jesus is the one of whom David wrote about in Psalms 110: Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; he seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, until I make thy foes thy footstool. Therefore let all
the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Acts 2:29-36. Jesus Christ is the one who sits at the right hand of God, and he is identified by the author of Hebrews as the high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek: So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, today have I begotten thee. As he saith also in another place, Thou art a priest forever after the order of Melchisidec. Hebrews 5:5-6. As will be seen in this chapter there are many ways in which gematria confirms that Jesus is this high priest as Scripture proclaims.

Jesus Christ is the high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek, the one mediator between God and men. The writer of Hebrews claimed that Jesus is the mediator of a better covenant. But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: Hebrews 8:6, 10. Gematria confirms that Jesus Christ is the mediator of a better covenant.

It is written in Hebrews that a priest who is similar to Melchizedek, and is eternal, will arise: And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest, who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. Hebrews 7:15. Could it be that Jesus is not only similar to Melchizedek, but that Melchizedek, as some have suggested, was actually a previous appearance of the Word of God upon earth? It is also written in Hebrews: For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; to
whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation, King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is King of peace; without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually. Hebrews 7:1-3. Melchizedek is said to have had no father and no mother, and had no beginning and no end. He was "made like the Son of God." This certainly sounds like the Word of God before he was made flesh in the form of Jesus Christ.

In Jeremiah, a Savior was prophesied: In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS. Jeremiah 23:6. Isaiah prophesied that the Messiah would be called the Prince of Peace: For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6. It should be noted from the verses in Hebrews that Melchizedek was called "the King of righteousness and King of Peace." Jeremiah wrote that the prophesied Messiah would be called "THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS," and Isaiah wrote that he would be called "The Prince of Peace." Melchizedek is called by essentially the same names as the Messiah, which is Jesus.

In the passage of Scripture that was quoted from Hebrews, Melchizedek is called, "King of righteousness," and "King of Salem." Observe the gematria association with these names for Melchizedek.

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Jesus is the high priest forever, who by giving his own life became the one sacrifice for sins of the world forever, to satisfy the Law: For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? Because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: in burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure. Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me,) to do thy will, O God. Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law; then said he, Lo, I come to do thy will, O God. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: but this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; from henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. Hebrews 10:1-14.

It is written that the sacrifices offered year by year continually can never make one perfect.

Sacrifices were required by the Law for forgiveness. However, works of the Law, such as sacrifices, cannot make a man perfect: Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be
justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Galatians 2:16. Another Greek word with the gematria value of 958 , confirms the truth in that regard.

Jesus offered himself as the one sacrifice for sins forever: But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God... In Scripture, "this man" can be written in three ways: using only the word for "man," only the word for "this," or using both words. These alternatives are used in the gematria evidence to follow.

The Messiah, which means "the anointed one," and is also the meaning of the word "Christ," is the one who offered one sacrifice for sins forever.

Because he was tempted in all points as we are, Jesus has compassion for our weakness. Unlike every high priest before him, it is unnecessary for Jesus to offer repeated sacrifices for $\sin$. He gave his life as the one sacrifice for sins forever, and through his blood there is forgiveness of sins, so that all men who acknowledge his sacrifice might be saved.
