Chapter 18

One God and One Lord

Throughout history there have been polytheistic cultures which worship many gods, while others have been monotheistic, and worshipped a single god. There are religions that are based upon the belief that everyone is a god and can reach a divine state of bliss through their own efforts. Some cultures have worshipped nature as representative of a spiritual presence within everything that exists. In his letter to the Romans, Paul wrote about those who worshipped the things of creation (which would include man himself) instead of the Creator: *Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, and changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever.

Amen. Romans 1:21-23, 25. The Bible clearly informs us that there is one God who is the Creator of all things: <i>Have we not all one father? hath not one God created us?...* Malachi 2:10.

The three main monotheistic religions; Judaism, Islam, and Christianity, all claim to worship the one true God, and each claims belief in the God who revealed himself to Abraham. In Judaism and Christianity, it is believed that God extended his promised blessings to Abraham through his son Isaac, his grandson Jacob, and their descendants. Islam differs in that they believe that the blessings from God flow through Abraham via Ishmael, the Son of Abraham and Hagar, the servant of Abraham's wife Sarah. The Old Testament of the Bible for the Jews, and both the Old Testament and New Testament for Christians, is said to be the word of God, and is the source for doctrinal teachings. Islam rejects the legitimacy of the Bible, and the tenets of Islam originated from the writings of Muhammad which accepted, in part, the teachings of Abraham, Moses, the prophets, and even Jesus, but rejected the biblical claim of the Jews as the chosen people of God, and the Christian belief in Jesus as the Son of God. Of the three monotheistic religions, only Christians believe that Jesus Christ is God who was manifested in the flesh, and is both fully man, and fully God. Which of these monotheistic religions does, indeed, worship the one true God?

The Lord God, the God of the Hebrew people, is one Lord, as proclaimed in the most sacred prayer of Jews; the Shema, which is named after the first Hebrew word of the prayer. *Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: and thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.* Deuteronomy 6:4-5. The Hebrew word, which in the KJV of the Bible is always written in capital letters, LORD, is the proper name of God. The anglicized Hebrew name of the Lord that cannot be pronounced in Hebrew is Yahweh, which in English is Jehovah. It is the name by which the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, first identified himself to Moses: *And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I am the LORD: and I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.* Exodus 6:2-3. The Lord God is the only God, as proclaimed by the prophet Isaiah in the following three verses: *Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.* Isaiah 44:6. *I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me...*

Isaiah 45:5. ...and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me. Isaiah 45:21. The Lord God, Jehovah, is the only God.

In the New Testament it is written that Jesus taught the same truth as the Old Testament prophets: And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: Mark 12:29. And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he: Mark 12:32. The Apostle Paul further emphasized that there is one God which justifies both Jews and Gentiles by faith: Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith. Romans 3:30. One Lord, one faith, one baptism... One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:5-6. In the book of James, it is written that even the devils believe that there is one God: Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. James 2:19.

Paul expanded upon the topic of one true God, and proclaimed that Jesus was our mediator with the one God: *Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but God is one*. Galatians 3:20. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 1 Timothy 2:5. Paul went on to teach not only that there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, Jesus Christ, but also that Jesus and God are one: As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one. For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,) but to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. 1 Corinthians 8:4-6. Furthermore, the words which John heard Jesus speak in the vision that he recorded in the Book of Revelation, are the words that were written concerning God in Isaiah 44:6: Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: Revelation 1:11. Jesus Christ is the Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: Revelation him there is no God.

So, there are many in the world that deny that there is a God, or worship many gods. Islam rejects the Jewish and Christian belief that the one true God established a covenant with Abraham that was carried on through Isaac and Jacob, and the Jews have rejected the fulfillment of their own messianic prophecies through Jesus Christ; a descendant of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and King David, from the lineage of his mother Mary. However, there is a prophecy in the Bible that foretells a time when there will be only one Lord over all the earth: *And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.* Zechariah 14:9.

If there is one God, the Father, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, as written in the Bible, then those who believe in any other god, or those who deny that Jesus Christ is one with the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, are in error. In the present politically correct world, this statement is looked upon as "hate speech." After all, it is commonly said that all religions are equally valid, and how can one be so arrogant as to consider that their religion worships the only true God? It is not "hate speech," but the love for others to proclaim that there is only one true God, and that belief in the Lord Jesus Christ is the only way to be saved; for it is written: *Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.* John 14:6. A true believer in Jesus Christ should proclaim to others the gospel message that Jesus is the only way to obtain salvation. This is what Jesus commanded of us: *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:* Matthew 28:19.

The self-avowed atheist, Penn Jillette, of the magician duo Penn and Teller, had something very interesting to say about Christians who proselytize. He had encountered a Christian who approached him after one of his magic shows, and the man told him how much he had enjoyed the show. The man then said he wanted to give him something, and he handed him a small book; a copy of the Psalms and the New Testament. Jillette said that he respected the boldness of the man's witness, and in his musing regarding the occurrence he said, "How much do you have to hate somebody to not proselytize? How much do you have to hate someone to believe everlasting life is possible and not tell them that?" If one proclaims that there is only one true God, and that Jesus Christ is the only way unto salvation, it is not a message of hate toward those of other beliefs, but only a concern for their salvation, and a desire to proclaim the truth of the gospel, so that they might also believe in the only true God; the only one who is able to save us, and offer eternal life to all that believe. Gematria provides evidence to support the claim that the Lord God is the one true God.

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: and thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: and thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates. Deuteronomy 6:4-9. The words of the Shema are not those of the prophet Moses, but are the words which God commanded him to say to the Hebrew people. Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it: that thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. Deuteronomy 6:1-2. The following two sentences that are written with Hebrew root words, for which the gematria value is calculated, confirm the command of God that was given to Moses. In this verse from Deuteronomy, the word with a gematria value of 401 (H853) was used with "thou shalt love." This Hebrew word is untranslatable in English and is used to point out more definitely the subject of a verb or preposition. The word is often not employed as in the following sentences.

As recorded in both Matthew and Mark, Jesus referred to the words from Deuteronomy when asked by a scribe which was the first, or most important, commandment. Master, which is the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Matthew 22:36-40. And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: and thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. Mark 12:28-31. Jesus said that we should love the Lord God, and love our neighbor as ourself.

It is written, (H3789) Thou shalt love (H157) the LORD (H3068) thy God, (H430) and thou shalt love (H157) thy neighbor (H7453) as (H3644) thyself.

Not only did Jesus speak the words that were written in Scripture commanding the people to love the Lord God, but he is the Lord God in the flesh, the one Lord, who is worthy of our love.

Hear, (H8085) O Israel: (H3478) The LORD (H3068) our God (H430) is one (H259) LORD: (H3068) and thou (H859) shalt love (H157) (H853) the LORD (H3068) thy God (H430) with all (H3605) thine heart, (H3824) and with all (H3605) thy soul, (H5315) and with all (H3605) thy might. (H3966) These (H428) words (H1697) I (H595) command (H6680) you this day. (H3117)

The first two commandments of the ten which God gave to Moses are related to the worship of God, and the prohibition against the worship of idols. Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Exodus 20:3; and, Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: ... Exodus 20:4-5. It is written by Paul in 1 Corinthians that an idol is nothing in the world, because there is only one God: As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know

that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one. For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,) but to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him. 1 Corinthians 8:4-6. The truth of Paul's words in this passage of Scripture is confirmed by gematria.

An idol is not limited to a "graven image;" it is any false god; which is anything to which one gives preference over their worship of the one true God. This might be wealth and materialism, status, worldly pleasures, or any of the things of this world, which are the creation of God. As Paul wrote, "an idol is nothing in the world." This statement is confirmed by gematria. (There are several Hebrew words that are used in the Old Testament for "idol," and there are several ways in which "nothing" can be written in Hebrew. The various options will be used in the gematria evidence that follows.)

An idol (H5566) **is nothing** (H3808) (H1697) **in the world.** (H8398)

Jesus Christ shed his blood upon the cross as an atonement for our sins; this is the new covenant between God and men. There are many who claim that Jesus was a good man and a great teacher, but deny that he is also God. Those who are not well acquainted with the Bible often say that Jesus never claimed to be God. Nothing could be further from the truth as these words of Jesus prove: *I and my Father are one*. John 10:30. Furthermore, this proclamation by Jesus is why the Jewish religious leaders of his day sought to kill him, as the three verses immediately after Jesus' claim that he and the Father are one clearly state: *Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him. Jesus answered them, Many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me? The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.* John 10:31-33.

The remainder of this chapter shows evidence that supports the Christian doctrine that Jesus Christ is one with the Father, through gematria values that are associated with the name of Jesus. There is one God, and one Lord, and it is Jesus, the Son of God.

A great number of gematria word associations have been shown which relate to the claim that was made by the Apostle Paul; that idols are nothing, and that there is no other God but one; one God, the Father, and one Lord, Jesus Christ. This is the amazing God who commanded Moses to teach the Hebrew people that the Lord God is one Lord, and the commandment to love the Lord God with all their heart, all their soul, and all their might. It should now be apparent that the identity of the one true God, the living God, and everlasting King, has been confirmed: it is the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the Holy One of Israel, who became flesh and dwelt among men upon the earth. He is the triune God; the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit.

Jesus Christ is the incarnation of the one, and only true God. There is no other God. This important truth must be proclaimed to a lost world that looks to idols, actual or symbolic, and to false gods, instead of the only true God: the Lord Jesus Christ, who is able to save.
