#### Chapter 2

## The Fool Says There is No God

Paul wrote that Scripture was written for our learning, that we might have hope: For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. Romans 15:4. When Paul wrote to Timothy, advising him to consider what he said, it was so that all might know the way to salvation, which is the hope that Scripture teaches: Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound. Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: 2 Timothy 2:7-11. In the verse which follows this passage of Scripture, Paul gives a warning to those who would deny Jesus: If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: 2 Timothy 2:12. To deny Jesus, the Son of God, is to deny God the Father also. Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father... 1 John 2:23.

Not only do many people reject the claim that the Bible was written by the inspiration of God, it has become commonplace for men to completely deny the existence of God, and Jesus his Son. The concept of God as the almighty Creator of heaven and earth has been rejected by those who consider themselves to be enlightened. Some believe that there is no absolute truth, and that everyone has their own "truth." For others, as the knowledge which mankind possesses has increased exponentially, it has now become widely accepted that truth is made known through the wisdom of man, and that which is true must be provable by reasoning and the scientific method. Those who rely upon reason to determine what is true assume that it is impossible to prove the existence of God by the methods that are used to study the material world, and therefore, to them, God does not exist. Any religion that is based upon the belief in an omnipotent God, especially one who is concerned with mankind and with whom one can commune, is viewed by such people as simply a myth created through the imagination of ignorant, superstitious, and foolish men. However, the most elementary of all sciences, mathematics, is able to prove that which is written in the Bible concerning those who deny the existence of God.

Belief in God is a matter of faith, but it is nevertheless a reality to those who truly believe, as it states in Scripture: *Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.* Hebrews 11:1. Faith, therefore, resides in the evidence which leads one to believe that which cannot be seen. The circumstances of mankind's existence should be sufficient evidence to prove the existence of God: the perfect position of the earth in relationship to the sun; the presence of a perfectly sized moon to allow for the movement of tides which are necessary for marine life, the perfect amount of water on earth, and the perfect composition of our atmosphere, both of which are necessary for life; these are just a few examples of the perfect balance in nature which allows for us to exist. However, the arrogance of man has resulted in using his knowledge of the natural world to deny God's creative power. Perhaps the findings which will be detailed in this book that were uncovered with the method of gematria which I have used will provide further evidence for the existence of God that might plant the seed for faith in the unbeliever.

Early on in my endeavor to use gematria to evaluate Scripture, there was a period of time in which I had experienced no inspiration as to how I might proceed. I began to doubt the validity of the numerical associations which I had recorded. Then I read a letter from a young man to the editorial page of my local newspaper in which he disparaged editorials that had been submitted by Christian believers in which they used Scripture to support their viewpoint. This person wrote that he had rejected the Christian faith in which he had been raised, and considered Christianity to be based upon a myth, and proclaimed that he had become an atheist. I was suddenly overcome with the inspiration to use the method of gematria I had happened upon to evaluate the following verses: The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. Psalms 14:1. The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: there is none that doeth good. God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek God. Everyone of them is gone back: they are altogether become filthy; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. Psalms 53:1-3. The gematria associations which I found in relation to the words of Scripture reveal that it is not those who believe in God who are foolish, but those who deny God.

A fool denies the existence of God.

The fool (H5036) has said, (H559) There is no (H369) God. (H430)

The Hebrew word used in the verses from Psalms for "corrupt" means: decay, ruin, destroy/destruction, perish. Gematria confirms that the unbelieving and faithless man who denies God, is corrupt, and he is destined to destruction.

The fool (H5036) has said (H559) in his heart, (H3820) There is no (H369) God. (H430) There is none (H369) that do (H6213) good. (H2896)

In the following sentence the word for "iniquity" with a value of 126 is the only change which has been made to the root words that are otherwise found in the verse.

It is written that God looked down from heaven to see if there was any man with understanding: God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek God. Psalms 53:2. The fool who says, "There is no God," is without understanding and, as Scripture says, has done an abominable thing.

The fool (H5036) has said (H559) in his heart, (H3820) There is no (H369) God: (H430) he is without (H3808) understanding. (H7919)

There is also a Greek word of this gematria value which is quite pertinent to those who deny God. According to Scripture there is no excuse for anyone to deny the existence of God because his power is made manifest throughout creation. Those who still deny God despite the evidence provided by the things He has created, and claim to be wise, are fools: For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, the just shall live by faith. For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools. Romans 1:17-22. The Greek word with a value of 883 as calculated for the last gematria example confirms that denial of God's existence is inexcusable.

As Scripture proclaims, God, the Creator of heaven and earth, is made known by all the things he has made.

Those who rely upon the knowledge and wisdom of man, and deny God the Creator, professing themselves to be wise, become fools. They have no understanding of spiritual things. The passage of Scripture states that those who do not know God "became vain in their imaginations." The Greek word used in this passage of Scripture for "imaginations" has the meaning of "reasoning," or "thought." It is written in Psalms: *The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity*. Psalms 94:11. In comparison to the omniscience of God Almighty the thoughts and reason of man are vanity. This fact is confirmed through the gematria value of the exact root words that are used in Psalms 94:11.

The LORD (H3068) knows (H3045) the thoughts (H4284) of man, (H120) that (H3588) they (H1992) are vanity. (H1892)

The passage of Scripture to which this verse refers is from the Book of Job: He taketh the wise in their own craftiness: and the counsel of the froward is carried headlong. Job 5:13. The Hebrew root word in this verse which is used for "taketh" means "to catch or capture." Note the Greek word and its Strong's definition that is found to have the same gematria value as the following sentence.

It is written, (H3789) God (H430) takes (H3920) the wise (H2450) in their own craftiness. (H6193)

The "wisdom of this world" is the belief that truth is found through reason, or what one personally thinks to be true, and not through acceptance of Holy Scripture as the source of the only absolute truth. Gematria confirms that the thoughts and wisdom of man who relies upon his own ability to reason, are not only vanity, they are foolishness with God.

He takes (H3920) the wise (H2450) in their own craftiness. (H6193)

In the Old Testament book of Jeremiah, there are three verses which speak of foolish people who do not know God. One verse says that they do not know the way of the Lord: *Therefore I said*, *Surely these are poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, nor the judgment of their God.* Jeremiah 5:4. The exact root words as seen in this verse are used in the next gematria confirmation (a word is not used for "nor" just as it is written in the verse.)

As can be seen repeatedly, the truth is still confirmed when different root words from those found in the Bible are used in a sentence, as long as the sentence remains consistent with what is written in Scripture. This can be shown when each of two different Hebrew root words for "foolish" are used in the following two sentences along with the root word for "they" which is not used in the verse from Jeremiah.

In the passage of Scripture from Isaiah 6, it is written that if the people would only "see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, understand with their heart, and convert," God would heal them. All mankind is without excuse when it comes to belief in God. The majesty of God's creation and the perfect balance of everything in the universe which makes it possible for us to exist is evidence enough to prove the existence of God our Creator. The amazing connection between the numerical value of words in the Hebrew and Greek languages which confirm what is written in Scripture is just one more sign for men to perceive that which may not otherwise be visible. To deny that there is a God is foolishness. However, throughout the world people of different cultures worship a variety of gods. Belief in "a god" is not the same as belief in the one true God.

One must be open to the inner voice of the Holy Spirit who will give understanding to what is written in Scripture regarding the way in which one can know God and obtain salvation through Jesus Christ. Salvation is only possible through the acknowledgment of Jesus as the Son of God, who came to give his own life as a sacrifice for our sins, and was raised from the dead, that we might live. The gematria evidence which supports this scriptural truth will be shown by a plethora of numerical associations in the chapters to come.
