David, the anointed King of Israel, from whose lineage Jesus arose, was not only a king, but was also a prophet. In 2Samuel it is written that God inspired the words of David: *The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue.* 2Samuel 23:2. There are many passages in the Book of Psalms, which is attributed to David, that are prophetic in nature. One such verse is found at the beginning of Psalms 110: *A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.* Psalms 110:1. Another verse in Psalms is prophetic in regard to the resurrection of Christ: *For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.* Psalms 16:10. These verses are clearly prophetic in relation to Jesus Christ, as the truth of these words is repeated many times in the New Testament.

The Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke, indicate that Jesus, himself referred to this passage of Scripture in order to prove his divinity: *While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The Son of David. He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?* Matthew 22:41-45. *And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the Son of David? For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool. David therefore himself calleth him Lord; and whence is he then his son? And the common people heard him gladly.* Mark 12:35-37. *And he said unto them, How say they that Christ is David's son? And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool. David therefore calleth him Lord, how is he then his son? Luke 20:41-44.* 

In his sermon at Pentecost, Peter also referred back to this verse in Psalms, along with another prophetic passage in Psalms related to the resurrection of Jesus: *Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; he seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, until I make thy foes thy footstool. Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. Acts 2:29-36.*

Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Ephesians 1:20. If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Colossians 3:1. Several times, the writer of Hebrews described Christ being on the right hand of God: Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; Hebrews 1:3. But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? Hebrews 1:13. Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; Hebrews 8:1. But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; Hebrews 10:12. Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2. Finally, in 1Peter, Christ is said to be on the right hand of God with all things being subject to him: Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him. 1Peter 3:2. It is obvious, from the repetition of that which was proclaimed by David's prophecy that is made in Psalms 110:1, that this is a very important concept. It is essential to Christian faith as it proclaims the divine nature of Jesus Christ; foreshadowing his resurrection, ascension to heaven, and the ultimate victory over all the enemies of Christ.

The truth of the prophecy is confirmed by using the numerical value of words in Hebrew and Greek. These are the languages of the OT and NT, respectively, and both written languages use characters of their alphabets as numbers. Gematria is the term that refers to the use of the numerical value of words to find hidden truth in Scripture. The method of gematria that is used in this article involves using the Hebrew root word spelling, and not the proper grammatical spelling, for each word in a sentence that is consistent with what is written in Scripture. The gematria value of the sentence determined in this way is then shown to have direct correlation with a Greek word or words from the Bible which have the same numerical value as the sentence. In the gematria evidence to follow, each Hebrew root word that is used in a sentence is identified by its reference number according to *Strong's Concordance*. Associated Greek words, which may be alternate spellings of the words which change according to rules of grammar, are also identified by their *Strong's* reference numbers.

Jesus was teaching in the temple when he asked the scribes who they thought that the prophesied Messiah, the Christ, was. When they answered him by saying that the Christ was the son of David, Jesus asked them how Christ could be the son of David, when David, himself, called him Lord. The two non-root word spellings in Greek which have the same gematria value as the following sentence confirms the truth of what Jesus taught the scribes.

King David, a prophet whose words were inspired by God, foretold the coming of Jesus Christ, and foreshadowed his resurrection, ascension into heaven, and his dominion with ultimate victory over all of his foes. The numerical value of Hebrew and Greek words related to the prophecy of David provides evidence to confirm the truth of that which David prophesied.
