Our Advocate and the Propitiation for Our Sins:

The first two verses of Chapter Two in 1John are a challenge for believers in Jesus Christ to not sin, but they also offer comfort in the fact that if anyone sins we have an advocate with the Father who is the propitiation for our sins: *My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: and he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.* 1John 2:1-2. Gematria which uses the Hebrew root word spelling for each word in a sentence confirms the truth of these two verses as the result of associated Greek words which have the same numerical value as the sentence.

John was challenging the people not to sin, but giving assurance that if anyone sins we have an advocate in Jesus Christ. In Greek the word for "advocate" has the meaning of "consoler or comforter." In the following sentence the Hebrew root word for "comforter" is used for "advocate."

My little children, (H2945) sin (H2398) not, (H3808) and if (H518) any man (H376) sin (H2398) we have (H1961) an advocate (H5162) with (H413) the Father. (H1)

Later in 1John it is written that God the Father sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins: *Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.* 1John 4:10. The Greek word for "propitiation" has essentially the same meaning as the Hebrew word for "atonement."

A true Christian is one who believes in Jesus Christ, the Son of God and Savior. What does it mean to be a Christian? It means that Jesus Christ is the propitiation for our sins.

Jesus (Yeshua) (H3442) Christ (the Messiah), (H4899) the righteous, (H6662) the only (H3173) Son (H1121) of God, (H430) is the propitiation (atonement) ((H3722) for (H5921) our sins. (H2403)
