## Believe on Whom God has Sent:

The Bible proclaims that God sent his Son, Jesus, to be the Savior of the world. And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world. 1John 4:14. Because God loved mankind, he sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins: In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1John 4:9-10. Those who believe in Jesus, the Son whom God sent, are given the promise of eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. John 3:16-17.

Jesus said that the work of God is to believe on whom he sent. Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent. John 6:28-29. What is the meaning of this passage of Scripture? Jesus spoke these words just after he had miraculously fed five thousand with five loaves of bread and two fish. He then went to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, and the people who witnessed the miracle followed him. The two verses prior to John 6:28-29, provide the context for the words which Jesus spoke: Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled. Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed. John 6:26-27. The people were asking Jesus what deeds must be done to earn everlasting life. Jesus' answer to them was that everlasting life comes only through belief in him, whom God had sent, and not through works. This truth was emphasized by the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Ephesians: For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. Ephesians 2:8-9.

Another way of looking at what Jesus said about the work of God and belief in whom he sent, is that faith in Jesus Christ comes to us through the power of the Holy Spirit of God. Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost. Romans 15:13. Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. 1Corinthians 12:3. Jesus spoke of this truth in his words to Peter, who had acknowledged Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God. When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am? And they said, Some say that thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. Matthew 16:13-17. So, belief in Jesus, whom God sent to be the Savior of the world, is all that is required to receive the promise of eternal life; but even

faith is not of our own doing, it comes to us through the Holy Spirit working to draw us toward God. This is the work of God.

Evidence for divine inspiration of Holy Scripture can be found through gematria, which uses the numerical value of words. This is possible because Hebrew, the language in which the Old Testament was written, and Greek, the language in which the New Testament was originally written, each has an alphabet in which the letters are also used as numbers. Therefore, each word has a gematria (numerical) value. In a variety of ways, the gematria value of words from the Bible have been used to imply divine inspiration of Scripture. Jewish rabbinical tradition has viewed words of the same gematria value to have an association. In this article I use a unique method as I have used in numerous other writings, in which the gematria value of sentences which state scriptural truth is determined based upon the root word spelling of each Hebrew word in the sentence, and not the grammatically correct spelling of the words. Greek words found in the Bible which have the same gematria value that was calculated for the sentence, then reveal a direct association with what is written in the sentence.

In each numerical word association that will be shown, the Hebrew words that are used are identified by reference numbers according to *Strong's Concordance*, the Hebrew words are written (from right to left); the numerical value of each word and the total is shown; and then the associated Greek words are written, and identified by their *Strong's* number.

The only work that is required to obtain eternal life is belief in whom God sent. This is the work of God

Jesus (Yeshua) (H3442) answered (H6030) and said (H559) unto (H413) them. This (H2088) is the work (H4639) of God. (H430)

We are called to believe on the name of Jesus. And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. 1John 3:23. In Greek, when it is translated as "believe in" or "believe on." a preposition is used, whereas in Hebrew of the Old Testament, the word for "in" or "on" is only occasionally used. In the following sentence, and in some others to follow, the Hebrew word for "in/on" (H5921) is used.

Each of the next four gematria examples has the same numerical value of 2167. The Greek words which have the same value confirm that the work of God is to believe on Jesus Christ, the Son whom God sent. In Hebrew, the word for "he" (H1931) is not always used along with the associated verb, and usually for emphasis. The next sentence uses H1931, and some other gematria examples to follow will also use the word.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1John 4:9-10. To believe in God is to believe in whom God sent, as Jesus is God manifested in the flesh. It is written in the Bible that those who believe in Jesus, believe in God who sent him: Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. John 12:44. All who believe in God, and Jesus whom he sent, are promised eternal life: Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. John 5:24. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. John 6:47. The promise of eternal life is given to believers because through acknowledgement of Jesus' sacrifice upon the cross as the atonement for all sins we are reconciled to God. To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins. Acts 10:43. The work of God is that salvation is through faith in Jesus' sacrificial death and resurrection alone. This is the truth of the gospel message. That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. Romans 10:9.

Belief in Jesus, the Son which God has sent, gives life.

Jesus, who is God, humbled himself and became flesh, and was obedient to the will of God the Father unto death. *And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.* Philippians 2:8. Jesus laid down his life for us of his own free will: *Therefore doth my* 

Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father. John 10:17-18. Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us... 1John 3:16.

It is impossible for any man to be free of sin. For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Romans 3:23. God will not allow sin in his presence, and according to God's law, the penalty for sin is death, which is eternal separation from God. But God sent his only begotten Son, Jesus, to save the world from sin, which the angel said to Joseph about the child Mary would bring forth: And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. Matthew 1:21. Jesus said that he came to save the world: I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. John 12:46-47. Paul, in his first letter to Timothy stated this same truth: This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners... 1Timothy 1:15.

By the death of Christ upon the cross, he has redeemed us from the curse of the law. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: Galatians 3:13. Although sin demands death; because of God's great love and mercy toward us, he sent Jesus to suffer and die for our sins, and through his sacrifice, those who believe are given the gift of eternal life. For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:23.

God's plan for the salvation of mankind was to send his Son to lay down his life as the atonement for all sin. The crucifixion of Jesus fulfilled God's plan. In the New Testament, the cross is often referred to as a "tree." Since there is no Hebrew word for "cross" in the Old Testament, in the sentences which follow, the Hebrew word for "tree" is used for "cross."

The customary interpretation of John 6:28-29, is that the answer which Jesus gave to the people was to make it known that salvation is obtained through believing on him, and not by works. Because of the wording in John 6:28-29, the message that belief alone is all that is necessary for salvation, is difficult to perceive for the reader who is not a biblical scholar. However, when the Hebrew equivalent of the Greek words that are used in these verses are evaluated using gematria, the message becomes clear. The Greek word for "believe" (G4100) has the meaning of: to have faith, to put trust in. All who have faith and put trust in the one whom God sent are "doing the work of God." The Greek word that is used in this passage of Scripture for "do" means "to make or do." The Hebrew word H6213 is translated as either "make" or "do." When Jesus was asked what should be done to "work the works of God," he answered that to believe on whom God sent was to do his works.

Throughout the New Testament of the Bible, it is proclaimed that salvation and eternal life comes only through faith in whom God has sent, his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ; and not through anything we can do ourselves. Salvation is a gift of God which he has offered by grace to all mankind because of his great love and mercy toward us. The numerical value of words provides evidence to support this essential Christian doctrine.
