The last two verses of the short book of Jude are as follows: *Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.* Jude 1:24-25. Jesus Christ is the only wise God and Savior, which is confirmed by gematria.

In the following sentence Hebrew root words are used which have the same meaning as those Greek words which are used in verse 25. (A word for "both" is not used as is frequently seen in Scripture.)

To the only (H3173) wise (H2450) God (H430) our Savior, (H3467) be glory (H8597) and majesty, (H1926) and dominion (H4475) and power, (H8633) both now (H6258) and ever. (H5769) Amen. (H543)

There are different Hebrew root words that can be used for "glory, majesty, dominion, and power." Some of the words are used interchangeably for "glory" and "majesty." The truth that Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, is the only wise God and Savior is confirmed by using the various words in different combinations along with a different root word for "wise."

To the only (H3173) wise (H7919) God (H430) our Savior, (H3467) Jesus (Yeshua), (H3442) the Son (H1121) of God, (H430) be glory (H3519) and majesty, (H1935) and dominion (H7287) and power, (H3581) both now (H6258) and ever. (H5769) Amen. (H543)

The following sentence uses the same Hebrew root words for "glory," and "power," but different Hebrew root words for "majesty" and "dominion." Although a word for "to" is not employed in the Greek translation of the verse, in the following sentence the Hebrew root word for "to/unto" is used.

To (H413) the only (H3173) wise (H7919) God (H430) our Savior, (H3467) the Son (H1121) of God, (H430) be glory (H3519) and majesty, (H1926) and dominion (H4910) and power, (H3581) both now (H6258) and ever. (H5769) Amen. (H543)

The sentence to follow uses yet a different Hebrew root word for "majesty," and the same root words for "glory, dominion, and power" as used in the previous sentence, as well as the root word for "wise" which was used in the first instance of gematria confirmation.

To the only (H3173) wise (H2450) God (H430) our Savior, (H3467) Jesus (Yeshua), (H3442) the only (H3173) begotten (H3205) Son (H1121) of God, (H430) be glory (H3519) and majesty, (H1347) and dominion (H4910) and power, (H3581) both now (H6258) and ever. (H5769) Amen. (H543)

One more instance of gematria confirmation uses the Hebrew root word for "majesty" as used in the second confirmatory sentence, the root word for "dominion" as used in the first example, and the same root words for "glory and power" as used in three of the sentences.

To the only (H3173) **wise** (H2450) **God** (H430) **our Savior**, (H3467) **Jesus** (**Yeshua**), (H3442) **the only** (H3173) **begotten** (H3205) **Son** (H1121) **of God**, (H430) **be glory** (H3519) **and majesty**, (H1935) **and dominion** (H4475) **and power**, (H3581) **both now** (H6258) **and ever**. (H5769) **Amen**. (H543)

Jesus Christ is the only wise God as confirmed by gematria. According to Jude 1:24, he is able to keep us from falling, and present us faultless before his glory.

Able (H3201) to keep (H8104) you from (H4480) falling. (H5307)

Two Greek words which are used for "wise" and have slightly different meanings have this same gematria value.

A sentence that consistent with what is written in Jude 1:24-25, using Hebrew root words to determine the gematria value, further confirms that this passage of Scripture refers to Jesus Christ.

Unto him that is able (H3201) to keep (H8104) you from (H4480) falling, (H5307) and to present (H5324) you faultless (H5355) before the presence (H6440) of his glory (H3519) with exceeding (H8057) joy, (H1524) to the only (H3173) wise (H7919) God (H430) our Savior, (H3467) the LORD (H3068) Jesus (Yeshua), (H3442) be glory (H3519) and majesty, (H1935) and dominion (H7287) and power, (H3581) forever. (H5769)

Similar to the words from Jude, Paul concluded his letter to the Romans as follows: *To God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen.* Romans 16:27. Gematria related to Hebrew root words according to what Paul wrote in this verse confirms once again that Jesus Christ is the only wise God.

To God (H430) **only** (H3173) **wise**, (H7919) **be glory** (H3519) **through** (H4480) **Jesus** (**Yeshua**) (H3442) **Christ (the Messiah)** (H4899) **forever.** (H5769)

In these sentences which restate with Hebrew root words that which is written in the New Testament, gematria confirms that Jesus Christ is the only wise God.
