

## The Anointing of Jesus:

There are two separate descriptions of Jesus being anointed prior to his entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. The first description merely states that a woman anointed Jesus: *And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured it on his head.* Mark 14:3. The second description states that it was Mary, the sister of Lazarus, who anointed Jesus: *Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead. There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him. Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.* John 12:1-3. Perhaps both of these descriptions are true, because each description of the event is confirmed by gematria. (Miriam is the Hebrew name for Mary.)

**She anointed (H4886) the Son (H1121) of God (H430) with (H5973) ointment (H8081) of spikenard, (H5373) and wiped (H4229) his feet. (H7272)**

**A POUND (G3046) OF OINTMENT (G3464) OF SPIKENARD (G3487) = λίτρα μύρον  
νάρδος = 441 + 660 + 425 = 1526**

**The woman (H802) took (H3947) ointment (H8081) of spikenard (H5373) very precious, (H3368) and anointed (H4886) Christ (the Messiah) (H4899) the LORD, (H3068) and wiped (H4229) his feet. (H7272)**

אשה לקח שמן נרד יקר משח משיח יהוה מחה רגל

233 + 53 + 26 + 358 + 348 + 310 + 254 + 390 + 138 + 306 = **2416**

In the Greek translation of John 12:3, a second word is used along with the word for “spikenard” which has the meaning of “genuine.” This word is used in the following confirmation of the above sentence.

**A POUND (G3046) OF OINTMENT (G3464) OF SPIKENARD (G4101) (G3487) = λίτρα  
μύρον πιστικός νάρδος = 441 + 660 + 890 + 425 = 2416**

The next four gematria examples confirm that it was Jesus Christ who was anointed with ointment of spikenard.

Jesus was sitting down for a supper to celebrate Lazarus being raised from the dead. Mary, the sister of Lazarus, showed her great appreciation by anointing Jesus with expensive oil.

**As he sat (H3427) there came (H935) Mary (Miriam) ,(H4813) and she broke (H7665) the box, (H6378) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard (H5373) very precious, (H3368) and poured (H8211) it on (H5921) his head. (H7218)**

501 + 100 + 400 + 310 + 254 + 390 + 100 + 502 + 290 + 9 + 312 = **3168**

**Mary (Miriam) (H4813) came (H935) with (H5973) a box (H6378) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard; (H5373) and she broke (H7665) the box, (H6378) and poured (H8211) it on (H5921) the head (H7218) of the LORD (H3068) Jesus (Yeshua). (H3442)**

386 + 26 + 501 + 100 + 400 + 100 + 502 + 254 + 390 + 100 + 110 + 9 + 290 = **3168**

**LORD (G2962) JESUS (G2424) CHRIST (G5547) = Κύριος Ἰησοῦς Χριστός = 800 + 888 + 1480 = 3168**

As the Bible states, the meal occurred six days before the Passover.

**Six (H8337) days (H3117) before (H2962) the Passover (H6453) Mary (Miriam) (H4813) came (H935) with a box (H6378) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard. (H5373)**

254 + 390 + 100 + 9 + 290 + 148 + 249 + 56 + 600 = **2096**

**ANOINTED (G218) the FEET (G4228) = ἀλείψω ποῦς = 1346 + 750 = 2096**

**Six (H8337) days (H3117) before (H2962) the Passover (H6453) Mary (Miriam) (H4813) came (H935) with (H5973) a pound (H4488) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard, (H5373) and anointed (H4886) the feet (H7272) of Jesus (Yeshua). (H3442)**

**Before (H2962) the Passover (H6453) a woman (H802) anointed (H4886) Jesus (Yeshua) (H3442) with a pound (H4488) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard, (H5373) and wiped (H4229) the LORD's (H3068) feet (H7272) with (H5873) her hair. (H8181)**

570 + 110 + 233 + 26 + 53 + 254 + 390 + 95 + 386 + 348 + 306 + 148 + 249 = **3168**

**LORD (G2962) JESUS (G2424) CHRIST (G5547) = Κύριος Ἰησοῦς Χριστός = 800 + 888 + 1480 = 3168**

Apparently, Mary not only poured the oil on Jesus' head, but also anointed his feet.

**She anointed (H4886) the feet (H7272) of Jesus (Yeshua) (H3442) Christ (the Messiah), (H4899) the only (H3173) Son (H1121) of God, (H430) with a pound (H4488) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard. (H5373)**

254 + 390 + 95 + 86 + 52 + 32 + 358 + 386 + 233 + 348 = **2234**

**ANOINTED (G218) JESUS (G2424) = ἀλείψω Ἰησοῦς = 1346 + 888 = 2234**

**She took (H3947) a pound (H4488) of ointment (H8081) of spikenard (H5373) and anointed (H4886) the feet (H7272) of Jesus (Yeshua) (H3442) Christ (the Messiah) (H4899) and wiped (H4229) his feet (H7272) with (H5973) her hair. (H8181)**

לקח מנה שמן נרדד משח רגל ישוע משיח מחה רגל עם שער

$$570 + 110 + 233 + 53 + 358 + 386 + 233 + 348 + 254 + 390 + 95 + 138 = \mathbf{3168}$$

$$\mathbf{LORD} (G2962) \mathbf{JESUS} (G2424) \mathbf{CHRIST} (G5547) = \text{Κύριος Ἰησοῦς Χριστός} = 800 + 888 + 1480 = \mathbf{3168}$$

Gematria confirms the story of the anointing of Jesus prior to his entering Jerusalem on Palm Sunday.
