Scripture Summary in Genesis 42:6-25

There was a famine in the land. Jacob (Joseph's father) found out there was grain in Egypt, so he sent his sons to buy some to keep their families from starving to death." Ten of Joseph's brothers went to Egypt to buy grain. Jacob did not send Joseph's younger brother, Benjamin with them because he was afraid something might happen to him. Joseph was the governor of Egypt and in charge of selling grain. His brothers did not recognize him, but he knew who they were, even though he pretended not to know them. Joseph kept them in prison for three days before letting nine of the brothers go take the grain back to their starving families. However, they had to return with Benjamin, the youngest brother, so Joseph would know they were telling the truth about their situation. Joseph could have taken advantage of his power by getting revenge for what his brothers did to him, but he did not.
