Who We Are:

The Metropolitan Detroit Diaper Bank is a 501 (c) 3 non-profit established in 2014. MDDB addresses the need for diapers in the community and fulfills the need through help of the community and corporate sponsors.

Who We Service:

800+ Families in Metro-Detroit are serviced by MDDB each month.

16,000 Diapers are provided for families each month.

192,000 Diapers are distributed by MDDB annually.

Diaper Need:

- 1/3 families report having diaper need.
- Diapers cost \$70-100 per child, each month.
- Diapers cannot be purchased with food stamps or government aid.
