Jeremiah 38:14-23

1. Read Jer. 38:14-16. (A) Give a brief background of Jeremiah, why was he called the weeping prophet? (B) Although Jeremiah knew God was with him, do you think he had feelings of trepidation, explain? (C) How can you tell if someone's "Christian intentions" are good or bad; do you think Zedekiah was obedient?

2. Read Jer. 38:17-18. (A) Explain the prophecy that Jeremiah gave to the King. (B) Give a brief background of Zedekiah, was he a righteous or wicked King? (C) How would you classify this prophecy favorable or unfavorable, explain; will Zedekiah be obedient?

3. Read Jer. 38:19-21. (A) Who are the Judeans and why is Zedekiah so afraid of them? (B) Explain the alternative that was given to the King; apply this principle to our lives today. (C) In your opinion, do you think Zedekiah was obedient?

4. Read Jer. 38:22-23. (A) Explain the meaning of this vision. (B) Please read/study Jeremiah 39:1-10; now give a brief sequential narrative to the outcome of Zedekiah. (C) What are some consequences of receiving or rejecting Godly - Biblical Advice?
