



Scripture Summary Jeremiah 38:14-23

Officials told King Zedekiah ■ that Jeremiah should be killed because his message about Judah's destruction if the Israelites did not surrender to the Babylonians made the soldiers afraid to go to battle. Zedekiah allowed the officials to do what they wanted with ■ Jeremiah so they put him in a well that had no water and left him there to starve. But an Ethiopian official in the royal palace told Zedekiah about the injustice done to Jeremiah and was given permission to rescue him. When King Zedekiah 🛮 asked Jeremiah again about 🛮 what the Lord told him, he promised not to kill Jeremiah or hand him over to anyone else to be killed as long as Jeremiah did not tell anyone about their conversation. Jeremiah told the Zedekiah if he did not ■ surrender to the Babylonians, ■ he would be captured and the city would be burned down.
