Scripture Summary Romans 10:5-17

People will not know they can call on the Lord for help, unless we tell them. Anyone who calls on the Lord to be saved, will be saved. And anyone who makes the decision to give their heart and soul to Christ will not regret it.

A few weeks ago, Zakiyah's neighbor, Miya, lost her battle with leukemia. Today was her homegoing celebration. Zakiyah attended the service with her parents. When the pastor opened up the floor for anyone who wanted to share a reflection, Zakiyah asked her parents if she could get in line. Zakiyah's father **accompanied** her in case she needed emotional support.

Zakiyah was a little nervous when she stepped up to the microphone. Every time she tried to speak, she got choked up with tears. Her father put his arm around her and said, "It's okay to cry sweetheart. Say what's in your heart."

Zakiyah started to feel less nervous. "Miya was my neighbor," she began. "When she first moved to the neighborhood, she did not go to church. We played together all the time, so, I invited her to Friends and Family Sunday. I could tell Miya was moved by the Holy Spirit, so, I asked her if she wanted to accept Jesus into her heart. I told her if she believed Jesus is the Savior of the world and wanted Him to be her Savior, all she had to do was say it out loud. I walked with Miya to the altar when the pastor gave the invitation to Christian discipleship. I was helping Miya learn the 23rd Psalm, the Lord's Prayer, and the Apostle Creed. But then she died. My parents told me God still loves and cares for us even when we do not understand why things happen the way they do. I am sad because I miss Miya, but I am so glad she **seized** the opportunity to be saved."

Zakiyah's mother gave her a hug when she got back to her seat. This moment helped Zakiyah realize the importance of sharing the Good News.


